b) The Christian is made for eternity

By his power God raised the Lord from the dead, and he will raise us also.

(1 Corinthians 6:14)





c) The Christian is united with Christ

Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ himself? Shall I then take the members of Christ and unite them with a prostitute? Never!

(1 Corinthians 6:15)





d) The Christian and illicit unions

Do you not know that he who unites himself with a prostitute is one with her in body? For it is said, "The two will become one flesh."

(1 Corinthians 6:16)





e) The Christian is God's temple

Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a person commits are outside the body, but whoever sins sexually, sins against their own body. ¹⁹ Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; ²⁰ you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.


